1. **PLAYER'S EXPERIENCE:** Your primary focus is to help your child and the coaches make their soccer team a successful experience for everyone. Be on time. Focus on the positives. Volunteer.
2. **BE A GREAT ROLE MODEL:** Demonstrate positive sportsmanship to all: referees, coaches, opponents, and parents. Help guide your child to win and lose graciously.
3. **SUCCESS:** A Team's success is not determined by wins and losses. Success is a combination of their enjoyment and play. When they love this game and play as hard as they can, that is success. Winning is a goal, often a result of hard work, but sometimes a team can play their best game and lose.
4. **RESPECT OPPONENTS, TEAMMATES, COACHES, REFEREES, GOVERNING OFFICIALS, AND SPECTATORS:** Fair play means respect. Without opponents, there can be no game. Demonstrate positive sportsmanship to everyone.
5. **COACHING:** Allow the coaches to coach. Cheer your child's success and raise their spirits during failure. Avoid analyzing and giving constructive criticism after games and practices.
6. **SOUTHLAKE IS A PRIVILEGE:** Playing for Southlake is a privilege and not a right. Realize this privilege is due to volunteers, coaches', and this community's commitment to youth soccer. We must all be stewards of this privilege to ensure Southlake continues for future players.
