## 2021 GRTYSA 6-A-Side Tournament Report

The 2021 Greater Renton Tukwila Youth Soccer Association (GRTYSA) 6-A-Side Tournament was held on Saturday, August 14, 2021 at the large grass field on the west side of Renton High School in downtown Renton. This was the 35th annual 6-A-Side tournament, and is the primary fundraising activity for GRTYSA and its Southlake Select Soccer program. The main focus of the 6-A-Side tournament was for players and families to have fun, hence the fast-paced, 6v6 game format. By this measure, the 6-A-Side was a great success and also a good fundraiser for our club. Normally 6-A-Side is part of Renton River Days but due to COVID, Renton River Days was canceled this year.

A total of 75 teams participated, 48 boys and 27 girls teams. All teams were from the state of Washington.

Teams were organized into 9 different brackets, with adjacent age groups pooled into the same group. There were sufficient teams to make a bracket for all age groups from U7-U19 except for GU15/16, although both U7-U8 and U9-U10 were coed divisions. This year only, players born in 2002 were allowed to play in the HS divisions due to the missing COVID year.

Games started at 9 AM and ran continuously until the last championship game concluded at 6:20 PM. All games were 15 minutes in length, 2 7-minute halves and a 1-minute halftime. The large grass field was divided into 6 soccer pitches, 2 of which were MOD-sized fields for U7-U8 and U9-10 games.

Champions were determined in all age groups except U7-U8 and U9-10, with preliminary group play consisting of a minimum of 3 games, followed by an elimination round that in some cases included both semifinal matches and a championship match, as proscribed by the 6-A-Side tournament rules. Medals for individual players were awarded for both first and second place. All players received 2021 6-A-Side tournament participation pins.

The quality of play reflected good sportsmanship, with no significant incidents of unsporting behavior or referee abuse. No cards were reported by Rich Turner, 6-A-Side tournament referee assignor.
